## Daily Readings and Follow-Up Questions:

Monday:

**Read: [I Corinthians 15:1-11](#)**

- What does this passage say about the evidence of Jesus' resurrection?
- What does it say about the importance of Jesus' resurrection?
- How did Jesus' death and resurrection change Paul's life?
- How does Jesus' death and resurrection change the way you live today?

Tuesday:

**Read: I Corinthians 15:12-34**

- What does this passage teach about the importance of Jesus' resurrection?
- What does it teach about our resurrection?
- What does it teach about hope?
- How does this passage challenge us to live?

Wednesday:

**Read: I Corinthians 15:35-58**

- What part of this passage stands out to you today?
- What does it teach us about God?
- What does it teach about the hope we have in Jesus?
- How does it challenge you to go and live today in light of that hope?

Thursday:

**Read: Ephesians 1:17-23**

- What does this passage reveal about God's character?
- What does it reveal about Jesus' authority?
- Pray this passage as your prayer to God for yourself today.

Friday:

**Read: John 20**

- Read the passage a second time, slowly.
- What part of this passage stands out to you today?
- What does it reveal to you about God?
- How can you go and live differently, as a result?
