

Personal Bible Study

Week of February 12 - Remain Connected to the Vine

Daily Scripture reading: John 15:6-8

Key thought: Throughout scripture, God repeatedly demonstrates a desire to be with His people. Through the work of Jesus Christ and the gift of the Holy Spirit, God now ABIDES **in** His people. How do we ABIDE in Him?

Directions: Read through the scripture reading. If you have the Bible App on your mobile device, try reading the passage in a different Bible version each day of the week as you pray and consider the following questions.

Follow-up questions:

Monday:

- God ABIDES in you.
 - $\circ~$ What does this tell you about Hid love for you?
 - How does this make you feel?
- What is one way this passage says you are to ABIDE in Him?

Tuesday:

- "Bearing fruit" is a result of our ABIDING in Him. What fruit is God producing in your life right now?
- How does the fruit in your life bring glory to God?

Wednesday:

- Augustine said, "our hearts are restless until they rest in you"... Is there anything causing you to be restless this week?
- How is God inviting you to ABIDE (to find rest) in Him this week?

Thursday:

- When we ABIDE, our life begins to resemble Jesus' life.
 - What visible signs/changes have you seen in your life that are a direct result of your relationship with God?
 - How have your desires changed?
 - How has your prayer life grown?

Friday:

- In his message this past week, Ryan spoke of a parent asking their recalcitrant child to "show them their hands."
 - Is there anything you are holding onto that prevents you from fully grasping God's hand?
 - What would it look like for you to surrender that to God?
- What does this scripture challenge YOU, specifically, to go and do?
