







1 In the beginning **GOD created** the heavens and the earth and **everything** in them, and it was good.

2 **He created man, perfect and part of his family**

But **man** rebelled and **disobeyed God bringing sin and suffering into the world.**

3 **God, being perfect and holy, made man leave His family, but being LOVE He promised to send someone to restore us into His family.**

He demonstrated that acceptance by raising Jesus from the dead on the third day, proving that He was Lord and Savior!

Whoever believes with his heart that God raised Jesus from the dead **and confesses** with his mouth that Jesus is Lord, **will be saved.**

Believers repent and are baptized in the name of the Jesus, buried with Him in his death and raised to walk in the newness of life.

God forgives us of all our sin, giving us the Holy Spirit within us and makes us part of His family again.
