- What was the woman's initial response to Jesus?
- What was the woman's life experiences like?
- What was her response to Jesus at the end of their conversation?
- What do you think she was feeling?
- What did she do about her experience with Jesus?

Follow these basic prompts in writing out your story. It will help you think through how God has been working in your life.

- Before I surrendered to Jesus, I was (angry, proud, afraid, doing things my own way)
- I realized I needed him when(I saw all the damage I had done, I couldn't fix it myself)
- I told him (I was sorry, I wanted him to be in charge)
- God is changing me to become (more thankful, less angry, more verbal about my faith)-
- Today I want people to know (I'm a follower of Jesus, You can trust Jesus, I'm clean in God's eyes)
- I want to share what I have discovered about and experienced in Jesus with (someone who does not yet know Jesus as Savior)
